| that equipment, where there is a change of user. This includes computers, keyboards, telephones, sneeze guards, desks. |
| Often used equipment must be cleaned even without change of user, frequently (at the start and end of each day, and at least hourly in between). This would include the following: phones, printers, computer keyboards, light switches, door handles, sneeze guards, PBT controls, pallet truck handles, personal equipment such as safety knives, etc. |
| Anti-bacterial spray should be used for the general cleaning of work surfaces (desks and kitchen tops), along with other display surfaces (please refer to the cleaning guidelines on Fuse). |

For stores with air conditioning in place, where possible, the system should be switched to a fresh air supply only, otherwise the air conditioning system will stay unadjusted and on, until government guidance dictates otherwise. Good ventilation is encouraged in order to help reduce the risk of spreading coronavirus | | |
